Commemorating St. Gaspar—January 6, 1786 is the birthdate of St. Gaspar del Bufalo, the founder of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood. He died December 28, 1837 in Rome, where he had spent the previous summer ministering to those affected by an epidemic of cholera. The physician who examined him said Gaspar died a victim of charity, worn out from his work for others. St. Gaspar was entirely devoted to his mission, which was to tell others about the redeeming power of the Blood of Christ. What's our mission, and how are we carrying it out? May St. Gaspar inspire us to be aware that we each have a mission, and that our lives have value and purpose.
