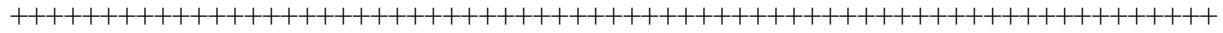

This weekend we celebrate the **Feast of All Saints**. We remember the saints who are canonized or beatified, and the multitude of those who are in heaven enjoying the beatific vision that are only known to God.
