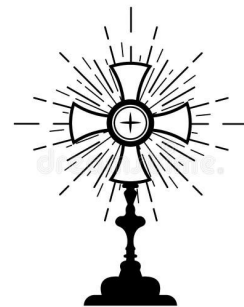
### **Altar Rosary Society – Immaculate Conception**
