

Gospel Reflection, This Week at Our Parishes | 3

GOSPEL MEDITATION DEEPEN YOUR UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

My friend and fellow pastor, Father Paul, noticed unsightly, overgrown trees near his parish church. He asked the maintenance crew to cut back the growth, which they happily did, telling him the trees would be much healthier and even fuller after a good pruning. A few days later, Father Paul received a letter from an irate man in the neighborhood who wrote, "Jesus would <u>never</u> prune trees like that. He loves trees, unlike you."

I suspect that the neighbor was not familiar with this week's Gospel in which Jesus says of his Father, "He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to make it bear more fruit" (John 15:2) | don't mean to pick too much on that fellow. He was perhaps ignorant of arboriculture. But I'd wager his main confusion was the pruning and removing quality of God's love. That confusion afflicts us all to some degree, doesn't it? It is just so darn easy to react negatively when God cuts something out of our lives and assume it's not his work at all. In the moment, all we see is the loss, and not the loving desire for future flourishing.

The cross is the great pruning of Christ's body. Jesus' rising is the brand-new growth. It is God's promise to us that all the painful pruning in life is leading us somewhere beautiful. What has been cut back or out in your life? A friend, an opportunity, a sense of certainty, a job, health, a relationship? This week, offer those dry branches to the one who lovingly prunes us in order to make our lives burst with verdant growth.

DISCERNMENT OF NEW MEMBERS FOR UNIFIED PASTORAL COUNCIL ST. ISIDORE, THE FATHER, FAMILY OF PARISHES

We are asking for those of you who are interested or know someone who would be a great addition to the Unified Pastoral Council to send in nominations. These individuals will have the opportunity to learn more about the role of a member and to sit in on a meeting to help the discernment process. Please send nominations to mfent@celina-ic.org.

NOMINATION

There shall be a minimum of five members discerned each year to replace the five members finishing their third year, therefore keeping the Family Council membership at 15 members. The Council shall maintain a gender balance, and at no time falling below a four to two balance. Nominations for new members shall even the balance, if necessary.

- **DISCERNMENT**—the nominations will occur in May. In June through a discernment process the candidate will be offered the opportunity to learn more about the pastoral council so that they can make an informed decision on being a member of the council. Discernment meeting details are as follows:
- 1) Opening prayer and introductions
- Welcome and congratulations
- This meeting is to begin a discernment process for being an active member of pastoral council. The evening dialog is a prayerful way for the group to call upon the Holy Spirit for guidance. Our hope is that this selection by discernment allows for all involved to find a place to be actively involved in service to the Family whether that be on pastoral council, the finance council, the worship commission or in some other important parish ministry.
- 4) We will look at the expectations of council members, meeting schedules, typical meeting agendas and a look at the next steps. You will have an opportunity to discuss your thoughts and feelings as well as ask questions.
- Overview of the purpose and functions of a pastoral council; Archdiocesan guidelines (the five challenges)


